Community health needs a totaly overhaul, but I can certainly offer some suggestions. I think that the first thing that needs to happen is a change of administration. I vote for Dr. Levine or Dr. Taylor to run the course. Next, the syllabus should either be re-written (by someone other than whoever wrote it the first time) or seriously revised. I felt that we were in the dark many times as to what exactly was expected of us, and that the rules for the paper, especially, were very unclear. The "journals" were a juvenile, repetitive, unnecessary waste of time, and if they are to be required, the least that can be done is to have interesting prompts; I could've cut and pasted my joural replies for most of the year. The class time we spent preparing for our intervention were a study in patience as well as a lesson in futility. There was no need for 6 months worth of preparation for 5 weeks (really 5 hours) worth of intervention. Does the government know how much money we are wasting on these "interventions?" Next, medical students are not social workers. I certainly understand the value of community service; I wouldn't be at Morehouse School of Medicine if I didn't want to serve my community. But I don't think that this course addresses the needs of the community or the needs of medical students. If the grant money for this course was used for actual community service (and I honestly believe that if you give a group of professional school adults a sum of grant money for community service, they will know what to do with it), it would be put to much better use than it was throughout the course of this class year. Next, I feel that I was repeatedly disrespected, patronised and mistreated throughout the course of Community Health. I was treated like a child and not a professional, and was subjected to gros manegerial incompetence. Class need not to be three hours at a time, two days before our real exams, or even every week. If we slimmed this course down and made it effecient, we could spend three weeks doing the assesment and the rest of the semester doing the intervention (which truly needs to be longer if it to be effective). In short, Community Health, while important, is not on Step 1, and therefore does not need to take up the entire year. Thank you.

Becoming more involved in the Atlanta community

I liked my site because it is beneficial to work with kids in the communities who need it. I do know that some people didn't find their site as worth while but it was a nice chance to get away from the classroom and into the community.

I love the Community Health course because I learned things I probably never would have learned on my own: how to assess a community's healthcare needs, create an intervention, implement and evaluate it. In my opinion, my group, led by Drs. Blumenthal, Daniels, and Ms. McCray, was the best group. After talking to my classmates I learned that our group was by far the most well-organized and efficient. The leaders each had very well-defined roles within the group and they complimented each other exceptionally well. In addition, our group leaders were approachable and very helpful. They assisted us and made outside resources available to us so we never felt like we had to re-invent the wheel to accomplish intervention goals. -For the amount of work that goes into this course and the amount of time taken from other foundational courses, this class is not worth enough credit hours. It should be work at least as much as First year FoM, which is 7 credit hours. We do so much more work in community health than FoM, and only get 4 credit hours. I believe that it should be work 10 credit hours.

-The course schedule does not coincide nicely with what we students have going on in our other classes. I do not believe that we should have community health the week of exams. This is very inconsiderate. I enjoy the course, but I am not happy about the way that it has been implemented

The semester-end papers did NOT improve my understanding of service-learning at all. Having the class write a scientific paper inevitably means that some people do all the writing, and so they resent their classmates who did not take up any slack. These negative feelings towards the class far outweigh any positive thoughts about the health interventions and any positive influences it would have made in the community. This ALWAYS happens, no matter how early the planning process for the intervention and paper begins.

Difficulties in the course come from doing the presentation when a major course exam and miniboard are scheduled within a few days of each other.

While it was wonderful to work with the St. Anthony of Padua Catholic Church community, in the beginning I thought that I would have had more interaction with my community each Wednesday. We did have representatives from the community when we were there but because our community was a commuter community and they were only there on Sundays, we really did not get to interact with them.

I realize the point of us working with the church is to get us used to working with others from a different faith/background. I would suggest that if that is the goal, perhaps a site at a religion-based school would have the same effect of working with those from other backgrounds but we would still get to see our community every Wednesday.

I thought the rules regarding allocating mponey for food was not equally regulated among the different groups. I felt we were required to do more work in terms of begging for money in order to facilitate many of our interventions, which focused on teaching the participates about healthy eating choices.

I feel the course could be done later in time to increase the students appreciation of what is being accomplished.

Too time consuming

I felt that the journals were rather repetitive in the end... I liked to talk about my site and the people we worked with but the same questions everytime- I didn't have much change.

The class lecture sections were not very engaging and seemed to be repetitive and irrelevant to some of our interventions. It is also difficult to work at a site that has already been the site of many interventions, because the task of coming up with a new idea that would be feasible becomes difficult for the students.

Time could be used more effectively. There is a lot of time that is spent doing tasks that could be completed faster than what is given. It effects students ability to balance appropriate time to other courses. The mandatory four hour sessions before large exams makes it difficult for the class to adequately prepare for exams. If the times could be moved around so as they are not

right before an exam block, this would be helpful.

Instructors should discuss with students, as part of the needs assessment, the previous interventions implemented at the site, along with descriptions of what worked and what didn't. This would allow the students to spend more time developing an intervention that will succeed and prevent them from creating an intervention that has already been tried and failed. I also suggest having community health exams separate from course exams. The material could be evaluated through quizzes at each group's site the week after the relevant lectures, allowing the students to focus on the material in a timely manner.

Get rid of the semester end papers, and have the students submit 3 or 4 reviews of scientific papers to gauge their understanding of how public health policies are enacted and analyzed.

Make it optional (those who complete can receive some type of fair credit), cut down to one semester, two papers and two presentations are repetitive, and unecessary.

I think other options for the journals would be more interesting for the readers and students.

Last semester our schedule was: Wednesday, 12/2--Paper due; Friday, 12/4--Independent study; Wednesday, 12/9--Presentation; Friday, 12/11--OS1 Final Exam; Wednesday, 12/16--Biochem mini-board. Perhaps we could have done the presentation on Friday, 12/4 instead of independent study, then had independent study on the Wednesday before our OS1 final exam.

I do not believe that the course should be cut completely out of the first year schedule, but I do think that it should be work at least 7-10 credit hours for the amount of work that we put into it. Also, the course should not occur on weeks of exams.

Some of the lectures seemed inappropirately placed: i.e the lecture when we returned from Christmas break. In particular, the Akintobi lecutre should come later in the semester. I would have learn more from the lecture if I had a better idea of our intervention.

The major projects are during stressful periods in the schedule.

I was a member of group 4 and we were placed at St. Anthony's Church. This was a HORRIBLE site to conduct a class on Wednesdays from 2-5pm. We had to give up too much of our free time on the weekends in an attempt to complete the objectives. Furthermore, we ran into numerous scheduling conflicts that messed up some of our scheduled events. Communication with the church was a hard task to accomplish. In the fall, everyone said they wanted to see certain things but when we had events in the spring, it seemed like no one was interested in participating. The group leaders were also a challenge. Dr. Buckner seems like a very vindictive person. When things do not go her way, it seems that she took pleasure in threaten our grades to force us to do something. On more than one occasion, she forced students to dance or participate in the exercise class when they stated that they would prefer not to. Her personality makes her unsuitable to teach students if she will treat them in such a manner. Ms. Geathers is a good

teacher but she also had some issues. She was more concerned with the students accommodating the church's schedule rather than following the schedule in the course syllabus in order to meet the objectives. Furthermore, from both instructors, there was blatant disrespect towards the students. We were constantly put down and talked to like we were children. On several occasions, a student would be speaking and the instructors would have a side conversation about something irrelevant. This was not a very enjoyable experience.

More should be done to make sure that all group members are equally participating and doing their work.

I did not find Ms. Geather's role as a group leader to be beneficial to my learning environment. Throughout the year I have seen her be rather rude to some of my classmates. I also did not feel like she really contributed much to helping us in planning a successful health intervention.

On the few occasions when Ms. Geathers led class sessions alone, there seemed to be a lack of organization and guidance.
