MSM's Calvin McAllister Teaches Class on Health Disparities at McNair High School



On February 11, 2017, MSM PRC Program Manager **Calvin McAllister, MPH**, had the opportunity to facilitate a class on Health Disparities and the Social Determinants of Health at Ronald E. McNair High School. This teaching opportunity became possible through MSM's partnership with the Southern Primary Care Consortium, Inc., Atlanta Area Health Education Center (SPCC Atlanta AHEC) and Project InstaLIFE. Project InstaLIFE grants high school juniors with the opportunity to conduct research on violence within the African American community.

Some of the objectives of Project InstaLIFE are for students to:

- Indicate improved awareness of trends in violence among the African American community
- Indicate improved knowledge of health literacy, social determinants of health, leadership, and advocacy for non-violent change
