



Mvskoke En'nenuce (Trail of the Muscogee)


Long before Europeans came to this area of Georgia, Stone Mountain was a gathering place and landmark for the Muscogee Creek Indians. This trail has been named in honor of the indigenous people who once inhabited the lands surrounding Stone Mountain. The trail name above is written in the official alphabet and language of the Muscogee Nation located in Okmulgee, Oklahoma.

Hiking Essentials

To conserve our wonderful natural resources at Stone Mountain Park, please practice Leave No Trace principles when out on a hike. You can help protect this special place by traveling on pre-existing trails, disposing of waste properly, respecting wildlife, and leaving what you find.

Consider purchasing a pre-assembled first aid kit. Trails can be slippery when wet and they often vary in terrain. It's better to be safe! For emergencies (police, fire or medical) use the Police call boxes located throughout the Park or call 770-413-5333.

Carry at least one water bottle and some food that provides energy, such as nuts or fruit. Be sure to hydrate prior to the start of the hike.

Wear sunglasses and apply sunscreen to prevent sunburn. UV rays are harmful even on cloudy days, so plan accordingly.

Pick up a Trail Map at either Memorial Hall or Confederate Hall to reference trail locations, places to park, etc. Connecting trails can take you to different areas, just be sure to know where you are going!
