### Session Descriptions

#### Education

##### **Teaching Through the Generations**

Participants will discuss how understanding of intergenerational differences can be used to enhance the educational experience for all learners.

##### **Evaluating Learners**

Participants will be provided faculty with the tools to effectively evaluate learners in a clinical setting and for faculty to understand the parallels to patient care.

##### **Keeping Current: Lifelong Learning**

Participants will understand the importance of continued education in enriching the instructional experience in light of the rapid increase of biomedical information.

#### Scholarly Activity

##### **Scholarship Reconsidered**

Participants will learn how to increase development of scholarly products through use of non-traditional academic activities.

##### **I Have a Research Idea...Now What?**

Participants will advance from a research idea to the development of scholarly products.

##### **Obtaining Funding**

Participants will understand the significance of funding to support scholarly activity.

#### Clinical Enterprise

##### **Strategic Plan Alignment**

Participants will understand how MHC will create and disseminate transformational models of care for vulnerable populations, leveraging the unique strengths of MSM.

##### **Patient Safety/Quality Improvement**

Participant understanding and usage of quality improvement metrics will improve by the end of the session.

##### **The State and Stature of MHC**

This session will demonstrate to participants how MSM's clinical enterprise will operate as a model to showcase best practices to achieve health equity.
