



Health Equity & Digital Divide in Kentucky




Kentucky Health Disparities

DIABETES BY POPULATION¹




MATERNAL MORTALITY RATE BY POPULATION²



HYPERTENSION 39% of all adults have hypertension ³




Social Determinants of Health in Kentucky
