ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

ARTICLE I

Name

The name of the Corporation is THE MOREHOUSE SCHOOL OF MEDICINE, INC.

ARTICLE II

Organization

The Corporation is organized pursuant to the provisions of the Georgia Non-Profit Corporation Code.

ARTICLE III

Period of Duration

The Corporation shall have perpetual duration.

ARTICLE IV

Purposes and Powers

- (a) The Corporation is organized and shall be operated for the establishment, support and maintenance of a school of medicine, which school shall engage in all those activities necessary and proper for the education of students to become licensed physicians, which activities shall include, but not be limited to, medical education at both the undergraduate and graduate levels, research, and the provision of medical services.
- (b) The Corporation shall have all powers necessary or convenient to effect any or all the purposes for which the Corporation is organized, including, but not limited to, the powers enumerated in the Georgia Nonprofit Corporation Code or any amendment thereto, and shall have the power to confer degrees and enter into contracts of guaranty,

suretyship or endorsement where the corporation guaranteeing has no direct interest in the subject matter guaranteed and to make purely accommodation guarantees, endorsements and contracts of suretyship.

ARTICLE Y

Election of Trustees

The affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by the Board of Trustees which shall exercise all of the powers of the Corporation. The qualifications, maximum number and manner of election of the Trustees shall be provided in the By-Laws of the Corporation.

ARTICLE VI

Initial Board of Trustees

The initial Board of Trustees of the Corporation shall consist of eight (8) members, whose names and addresses are as follows:

ARTICLE VII

Restrictions

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article IV hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (by publishing or distributing statements or otherwise) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law).

Dissolution

The assets of the Corporation are irrevocably dedicated to educational purposes. In the event of the dissolution of the Corporation, the Board of Trustees shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the Corporation, convey or dis-

tribute all of the assets of the Corporation to or for the

benefit of Morehouse College, Atlanta, Georgia, in accordance with an agreement to be reached between the Morehouse College and the Corporation, or in the event the Morehouse College is no longer in existence or does not then qualify as an exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, (or the corresponding provision of any United States Internal Revenue law), to such other organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for educational purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under such section or corresponding provision, as the Board of Trustees shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Superior Court of the County in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE IX

Registered Office and Agent

The address of the initial registered office of the Corporation shall be 830 Westview Drive, Atlanta Georgia 30314. The initial registered agent of the Corporation at such address shall be Louis W. Sullivan.

ARTICLE X
