What is MILLA?

Participants will have the opportunity to engage in a hybrid leadership development training program. This program is designed to empower and equip emerging leaders with the skills and resources necessary to make a positive impact on our institutional culture and infrastructure.

Eligibility Requirements

- ✓ Nomination from, and/or endorsed by, a member of the MSM Leadership Council.
- ✓ At least 12 months of employment with MSM.
- ✓ Have a documented 3.0 or higher on performance evaluations.
- ✓ Be on the faculty at the associate professor rank or above or staff at the coordinator, manager, director, or similar level.
